### Pairing

Goes well with a roasted lamb gigot with herbs, served with coarse-grained polenta.

### Tasting notes

Rich, luminous ruby. Very compact nose with intense notes of ripe dark cherries, warm and inviting, with a background of cloves. Appears very polished on the palate, opens with present and fine-grained tannin, builds up layer by layer, in the finale a long finish.
