Luigi Dolzan has no doubts: for him, grappa is the best distillate in the world and he is sure of the top quality of his grappas, produced according to his "Methode de Varda."

Appearance: Intense amber color tending towards golden yellow, inviting. Scent: Particularly warm and soft, with noble finesse and intensity, with an exceptional personal style, pleasantly fruity with notes of Maraska cherry, blackcurrant, raspberry, very ripe red berries, with a clear smell of elderberry, lilac, field flowers and orange

blossoms, with a roasted nuance of coffee, almonds, cocoa, amaretto, nougat, fresh pastries, vanilla. Taste: Particularly soft, with an extraordinary wealth of aromas, fine, elegant, round, velvety, warm, persistent, sensual, rich, magnificent bouquet with fruit, blossom, vanilla and toasted notes.
