On the nose, a refined and aromatic scent of vanilla, apricot, maraska cherry, black currant, blueberry and ripe red berries with hints of toasted notes of hazelnut, pistachio, cocoa, coffee, carob and amaretto. Creamy, floral, soft and elegant on the palate. In the finish aromas of flowers, spices, vanilla and toasted notes.
