### Comments

Ried. Bärnreiser in Höflein Soil. deep, warm loess soils with gravel alluvial deposits  
 Climate. Bärnreiser is one of the warmest sites in our region. Its deep soils store the heat of the day and slowly release it again over night. This ensures a perfect water and nutrient supply for the vines, as well as constant warmth, and the Merlot grapes almost always reach their peak ripeness here.
