Comments

Apart from the difficult topography, these plots are very well ventilated and are located at the very top of the slope, where the temperature is cooler than on the edge of the lake. This criterion is crucial to enhance the typical fruit aromas of this grape variety.

Pairing

Aperitif as an alternative to white wine, fresh or aged goat cheese, vegetable tarts, white meat: baked chicken, veal blanquette with morels, rabbit with mustard, fried mushrooms, Papet vaudois.

Tasting notes

Invigorating opening with aromas of black cherry, blackberry leaf, rosebud and oregano on the nose. The middle is fruity and is enveloped by dense, fine tannins; the finish is tannic and effervescent. A juicy and fruity wine that is reminiscent of summer fruits and constantly leaves you wanting more.
