### Comments

"Primitivo is the grape variety from which we generally obtain rich and long-lasting red wines characterised by softness and opulence. Characteristics that seem far removed from the idea of rosé wine. However, only apparently, because much depends on the management of the vineyard. Primitivo is a grape with particularly pronounced notes of small berries that become ripe fruit and jam in red wines as they mature. A grape with these characteristics, harvested between the second and third decades of August, before the usual drying process of Primitivo sets in, makes it possible to obtain rosé wines with particularly fruity notes and an enviable freshness."
